English: Brightstorm

We will be using our core book 'Brightstorm' by Vashti Hardy to inspire our writing. We will create a persuasive letter and write our own narrative linked to this book.

<u>Reading:</u> For our comprehension focus we will explore a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts using our skills of retrieval and inference to answer questions.

Maths: Place Value

This half-term we will be learning all about place-value in numbers up to one million. including comparing and ordering numbers and rounding before moving on to addition and subtraction. We also learn about multiplication and division whilst continuing to embed our multiplication facts.

RE: How can following God bring freedom and justice? The children will make connections between the story of Moses and the concepts of freedom and salvation. They will understand the ways in which some Christians put their beliefs in to practice by trying to bring freedom to others.

Computing:

This half term we will be thinking about e-safety. We will also investigate computing systems and networks.

Science: Sun, Earth & Moon: What is moving and how do we know?

As Scientists, we will investigate the movement of the Earth and other planets around the sun. As well as exploring the phases of the moon and finding out why we have day and night.
